All parents/guardians who have children participating within the Midwest Rams Youth Sports and Cheer Association must abide by a code of conduct which includes the provisions that follow.

Any violation of these rules may result in the revocation of privileges in the Midwest Rams Youth Sports Association.

1. I/we hereby pledge to provide positive support, care, and encouragement for my child participating in youth sports by following this Parent Code of Conduct.
2. I/we will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, cheerleaders, coaches and officials at every game, practice, or other youth sport event.
3. I/will support coaches and officials working with my child, in order to encourage a positive and enjoyable experience for all.
4. I/we will remember that game day is for youth -not ADULTS.
5. I/we will do my/our best to make youth sports fun for my child.
6. I/we agree to pick up my/our child(ren) in a timely manner after any Midwest Rams Youth Sports practice, game or event.
7. I/we will ask my child to treat other players, cheerleaders, coaches, fans, parents, and officials with respect regardless of race, creed, sex or ability.
8. I/we agree to be financially responsible for the Midwest Rams Youth Sports sporting equipment issued to the applicant other than normal wear and breakage during games and practice. Further, I/we will reimburse the Midwest Rams Youth Sports for the loss and/or damage to said equipment.
9. I/we agree NOT to smoke on the practice or playing field/facility, or in the presence of a gathering of a team/squad.
10. I/we agree to abstain from the possession and drinking of alcoholic beverages and the possession or use of any illegal substance at any Midwest Rams Youth Sports functions.
11. I/we agree not to be on the playing field/sidelines/court during practices/games unless I/we are coach-appointed volunteer(s) serving a specific purpose.
12. I/we agree not to deliberately incite or participate in "unsportsmanlike" conduct at any Youth Football function.
13. I/we agree not to use abusive or profane language at any time at any Youth Football function.
14. I/we agree not to criticize, belittle, antagonize, berate or otherwise incite the opposing team, its players, coaches, cheerleaders or fans by word of mouth or gestures.
15. I/we agree to accept all decisions of the game officials, judges, or Midwest Rams Youth Sports officials as being fair and called to the best of their ability.

16. I/we agree not to interfere with or come near the "scale area" at the field/facility, where the weigh-in and pregame check-in is taking place with the Midwest Rams Youth Sports.
17. I/we agree to follow the proper chain of command when filing a complaint or voicing my opinion regarding any possible rule infraction or concern within the Midwest Rams Youth Sports. (As follows):
 - a. Head Football/Cheer Coaches
 - b. Business Manager
 - c. Vice President
 - d. President and Board of Directors
18. I/we agree to take responsibility for any actions that violates this code of conduct by a guest or relative of attending parents/guardians.
19. I/we agree not to bring any food, drinks, or coolers into any stadium/park/court during a Youth Football/Cheer game.
20. I/we agree that any act of disrespect from a parent/fan directed towards game officials/judges, or Conference officials, creating a disturbance either in the stands or on the playing field, or has to be ejected from a game, practice or event, by the Midwest Rams Youth Sports official or game official, the penalty will be handed down to that individual immediately by the Midwest Rams Youth Sports official, and the assessed penalty will not require a hearing to be assessed.
21. I/we agree to return all sports equipment at the end of the season. I/we agree to pay full retail price of all sports equipment not returned no later than a week after the season.
22. I/we agree that any violations of the above may result in a verbal and/or written warning (1st offense); suspension (2nd offense); and or expulsion (3rd offense).
23. I/we agree that severe violations may result in immediate suspension or expulsion by the Board of Directors.
24. I/we agree that any fees paid will be forfeited upon expulsion from the Midwest Rams Youth Sports Association.
